Peter Bradley-Fulgoni’s profound human spirit supported by a muscular and energised pianism gives us a renewed “Emperor” full of buoyancy, elegance and majesty with solid orchestral support by the Sinfonia of Leeds under the direction of David Greed. The solo items included on the CD by Galuppi, Zipoli, Rossi, Pescetti as well as Bach and Rameau are polished jewels of priceless currency. Peter Bradley-Fulgoni is a great pianist who brings a terrific sense of occasion to all that he plays.
